Scheduled Ramp Closures

Boston Street Ramp to I-95 Southbound – closed approximately 8 weeks
May 2006 thru July 2006

Keith Avenue Ramp to I-95 Northbound – closed approximately 11 weeks
July 2006 thru September 2006

Keith Avenue Ramp to I-95 Southbound – closed approximately 5 weeks
September 2006 thru October 2006

Keith Avenue Ramp from I-95 Northbound - closed approximately 6 weeks
October 2006 thru December 2006

Additional Weekend-Only Ramp Closures

Keith Avenue Ramp from I-95 Southbound - closed approximately 3 to 4 weekends
Could occur between May 2006 thru July 2006

Keith Avenue Ramp to I-95 North and Southbound - closed approximately 4 weekends
Could occur between July 2006 thru October 2006

Boston Street Ramp from I-95 Northbound – closed approximately 3 to 4 weekends
Could occur between May 2006 thru October 2006

Interstate Avenue Ramp to I-95 Northbound – closed approximately 3 weekends
